ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The golden pages of history witnessed an educational revolution in the year 1993 with the inception of NMS Sermathai Vasan college for women, by Nadar Mahajana Sangam with a mission to uplift the educational status of women in and around Madurai. The college was named after the benevolent philanthropist Thiru. V.G. Vasan and Thirumathi. Sermathai Vasan, who believed the empowerment of women is through knowledge and economic independence. "The hand that rocks the cradle can rock the world" is the vision of Kalvithanthai. Thiru. V.P.R. Gangaram Durairaj, the founder of the college. The college is presently run by Nadar Mahajana Sangam, and hails its preeminent status among several educational Institutions run by the Nadar Mahajana Sangam by providing quality and task based learning environment. The college is housed at the outskirts of Madurai in a serene and spacious environment and permanently affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University.

A thousand mile journey starts with a single step; the college takes its first step with an intake of 100 students, 3 departments and 7 faculty members. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATION

REGULAR WORKING HOURS :

- 1) Regular class hours begin from 9.25 a.m. and ends at 4.00 pm. The stipulated working hours is divided into six hours with a break and a lunch break.
- 2) An inter religious prayer in a common assembly on first Monday of every month initiates Sanctity of the college. On all other days, Principal will address the students by public address system. The first bell goes at 9.25 a.m.

ATTENDANCE PARTICULARS

1. Everyday attderance will be marked at the beginning of 1st hour and absentee namelist is enrolled and intimated to the parents at the begining of the day, (morning) through sms from the college office.
2. Attendance is mandatory on all days including college functions.
3. On working days, if a student needs leave, she should get prior permission from the Head of the Department.
4. Available prescribed application form must be obtained from the office, by the student to avail leave.
5. On genuine reasons, leave will be sanctioned and Prior permission is must to students to attend family functions.
6. Leave form of the boarders must be duly signed by HOD, Principal, Residential Tutors and parents before availing leave. In case of dayscholars, leave form must be duly signed by the parents and HOD.
7. No attendance will be there to a student if she absents hereself from the regular class without prior permission. Continuous absence without leave letter will not be permitted to appear for university examinations.

8. There is no re-test to the students who absences herself on internal examination days.
9. On medical grounds the students may be permitted to re-appear for the internals, if she is absent on the internal days
10. 68 days of attendance is mandatory according to the rules of Madurai Kamaraj University. Students having minimum attendance days (or) without attendance cannot have the priority of attending semester examination.

REQUEST TO PARENTS / GUARDIANS

Parents / Guardians are requested to extend full co-operation to the authorities with regard to the character, discipline and academic progress of their daughter / wards. They must respond to all communications sent to them from the College pertaining to their / wards. All the parents / guardians are requested to attend the parents teachers meet.

GENERAL REGULATIONS :

1. Every student should behave herself in the college campus in a dignified manner and every student is responsible to maintain decorum in the classroom and college campus.
2. Every student should maintain eco-friendliness in the campus.
3. Every student must strive to create an atmosphere of friendliness and good cheer in the College. Students are expected to maintain cordial relationship with staff and other students.
4. Students are always expected to admonish dress code (in saree or chudidhar) in accordance with approved etiquette, decency and dignity. Midi Short chudi, Jeans pant, leggings & shirt are not allowed. Free hair is prohibited within the college

premises. Third year are asked to wear saree on 2nd & 4th Friday of the Month

5. Students are to be extra courteous, polite and lady - like in their behavior.
6. Students should not loiter in the verandas of the college during and between class hours.
7. The college takes no responsibility for any article lost by the student.
8. No student shall participate in acts tending to discredit the Institution.
9. Students are forbidden to organize any meeting / party / get together in college without written permission from the Principal.
10. Letters addressed to students in the college are subject to scrutiny by the Principal.
11. No collection / subscription of any kind is allowed without the knowledge and consent of the Principal.
12. Requests, petitions, appeals and complaints of any kind can be made only to the Principal.
13. Without prior permission of the Principal, no student can consent to give talks or orations outside the College.
14. Students are allowed to bring Laptops on the basis of restrictions. Laptops are to be used only for academic purpose. Students are responsible for their properties.
15. Students who trespass the code of conduct of the College, will be dismissed.
16. Students are expected to notice the matters put up on the College notice board. Ignorance of any such notice will not be

accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with matters put up on the College notice board.

17. Any book, magazines or notices which are in no way related to the subject are not to be brought into the College campus.
18. All Students should take active part in extra curricular activities of the College. Students shall conduct themselves with dignity and decorum during meetings and functions.
19. Students are required to spend their leisure hours in library.
20. Students damaging the college property and scribbling on the walls will be fined.
21. Ragging is punishable. If any student involves in ragging, they will be dismissed from the college.

TUTOR WARD SYSTEM

1. A batch of students will be assigned to each faculty member who will function as their counsellor / Tutor.
2. The Tutor will meet their students at least once in a month in the College.
3. The Tutor looks after the wards' attendance, progress, health and general behaviour. It is desirable to rectify the short comings of the students at the very outset.
4. Tutor will keep a record of necessary particulars about their wards in the record supplied for the purpose.
5. The Tutor at the end of the terminal examinations will enter the marks of their wards updations and comments will be given.

LIBRARY:

1. Membership is obligatory for students.
2. The library is opened from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m
3. One library ticket will be issued for UG students and two tickets will be issued for PG students.
4. To enter the library, the students should leave the books, note books, bag, etc., on the rack assigned for them.
5. The identity cards and library tickets should be preserved safely. Library books should not be borrowed from others. Before leaving the counter, the pages and books will be checked. Scribbling, underlining, tearing of pages and other damages to the library books are strictly forbidden.
6. Students are requested to cover the books while they handle the books. If books are not returned on due date a fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be collected.
7. All books must be returned to the library before study holidays.
8. Final year students should return the library tickets before the last working day.
9. Reference books should be used only in the library and they will not be issued.
10. Absolute silence shall be maintained inside the library.

STUDENT TRAINING PROGRAMMES

NSS

There are Four units of NSS 88, 89, 90 & 91 with 400 students. Through this scheme the students are made aware of their environment and realize their responsibility in society. They have annual special camps during this time their service to the people in the rural area will motivate the students, make them cultured as well as the society.

NSS

The NCC army wing functions in our College to instill the young minds with discipline and a sense of patriotism belonging to our country. Through regular parades, they get training to take up the 'B' and 'C' certificate examinations and get sometimes the honour to participate in the Republic Day parade. By attending various camps held at inter state level, the students get a wide exposure and gain a healthy expansion of their horizon and contacts.

SPORTS & GAMES

The college gives importance to sports and games. Our teams have distinguished themselves in volley ball, athletics, and various other games. our students participate in inter-collegiate tournaments at the university, District and State levels. The candidates with distinctions in various games and athletics are given special consideration during admission.

Apart from training programmers, we have Karate, Silambam, Red Ribbon Club and Youth Red Cross Society for helping the students to have a harmonious development in all fields.

FEE AND FEE CONCESSION AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS:

The Students must pay the fees within one month after reopening. Otherwise fine will be levied.

The Management and the Government, (both the State and the Centre) financially help students for their study. Eligibility conditions are announced when needed. These scholarships and stipends should be applied only after the remission of full fees for the first semester and after enrollment in the College. Scholarship and fee concession holders must secure 90% of the attendance failing which they run the risk of losing these scholarships and concessions. Those student who have completed their UG Courses in our college will be given tuition fees reduction if they join here for PG Courses.

ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION:

Every old student of the College is expected to become a member of the Alumnae Association. She can enroll herself as an annual member or obtain life membership. Outgoing students in the College are enrolled as members of the Association before they leave the College. Life membership is very much encouraged to build up longstanding link with the Alma Mater

FIELD TRIPS : INDUSTRIAL VISITS

Respective department faculties will organize educational tours, field trips and Industrial visits to students.

Hostel is situated inside the College campus. The mess runs with dividing system. Admission to the College hostel is available to students whose parents / guardians reside outside Madurai or remote areas of Madurai.

Rules & Regulations

5. If the Students have to go home other than the week end, their parents should come in person and get permission. No phone message or letter will be accepted.
6. No mess reduction for those who take leave less than 5 days and for those who take leave without prior permission.
7. Visitors are not allowed to see the students during working days.
8. The day students or visitors should not enter into the hostel rooms.
9. The mess fee must be paid before 20th of every month.
10. Laptop can be brought other electronic device is strictly prohibited. If found, severe punishment will be inflicted.
