The programme was presided by Mrs.M.Thenmozhi,VicePrincipal.The programme began with a **Welcome address by Mrs. M. Pushpa Rani, IQAC Coordinator**, who highlighted the importance of road safety awareness and the need for basic life-saving skills during emergency situations.
